Misho relocated to Thailand in early 2020 to escape the worsening coronavirus threat in San Francisco, where he was based since 2009. He has exhibited in Asia on several occasions, and he continues to explore relationships between Asian and Western culture and art. Misho's practice is often grounded in his connection to the natural environment. Concerns over climate change come to the fore in the photographic series Imaginary Landscapes, where Misho pictures scenes of an alternate reality, or perhaps a vision of the future. Created with digital collaging techniques, worn and decaying surfaces of the urban environment play background to superimposed trees. Whether these trees are monuments to the past or symbols of rebirth, Misho leaves up to the viewer.
